The globe-trotting, influential Lee is everything Marjorie is not, and her company revitalizes her. But neither Marjorie's allergist husband, Ira, her mother, nor anyone else has actually seen Lee, and they suspect she is a figment of Marjorie's imagination. But it turns out Lee is more than real, and her manipulation of the Taubs' money and even their sex life has a positive effect.

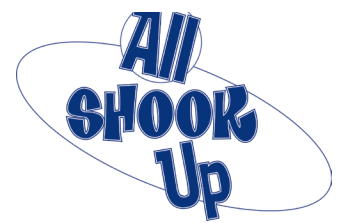

DRIVING DIRECTIONS

From **Route 378** take exit for **Eighth Avenue** travelling **NORTH**. Follow Eighth Avenue for 3 traffic lights. At third light Eighth Avenue **BEARS LEFT** and merges onto **Schoenersville Road**. Follow this direction for one block, passing sports' fields on your right. At next traffic light turn **RIGHT** onto **Illicks Mill Road**. The Playhouse is less than a mile on your **LEFT**, just beyond the entrance for **Bethlehem Municipal Golf Course**. The parking lot across the road from the theater is for our patrons.

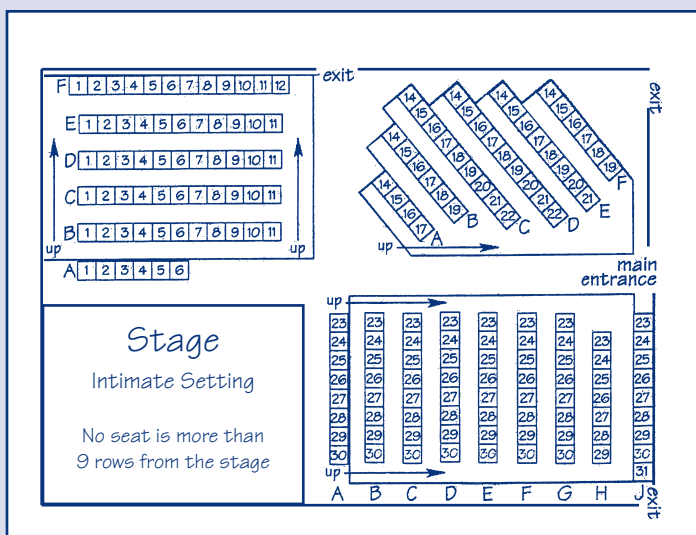
